How the show works

Everyone in Grade 1 Ballet/ Grade 2 Modern and above will be included in our Opening Number.

In the past Baby Ballet have only performed in the afternoon show, but I will be bringing the start time of the evening show forward this year so there is a possibility of them doing both shows and this is open for discussion.

OPENING NUMBER

Children must be available to film on Monday 8th April (Easter Hols) and attend 2 rehearsals on Sun 10th and Sun 17th March, time and venue TBC. The rehearsals will be the only opportunity to learn the choreography.

AUDITION

To Audition to take part you will need to submit a video via Whatsapp of your child following the criteria listed below by Sat 2nd March. (07939509613)

Younger students: will need to open a book and show a reaction to what's inside it- whether it's funny, sad, scary, amazing etc. Lastly you will need to show them dancing for no longer than 30 seconds to a Million Dreams from The Greatest Showman- this can be improvised or devised by them beforehand.

Older students: will need to either improvise or devise a 30 second performance to a Million Dreams from The Greatest Showman which includes the use of a book.

Successful children will have demonstrated lots of animation in their performance as well as a connection with the music. The actual dance will be Choreographed by me.

The following classes will be dancing together in the show and will require a rehearsal together after Easter. TBC

- Pre-Primary and Primary Tap (Brixton)
- Primary Ballet A & Primary Ballet (Newton and Roborough)
- Grade 1 Modern (Brixton and Roborough)
- Grade 2 Tap/ Grade 3 Modern (Tues and Wed classes)
- Grade 2 and Grade 3 Ballet (Mon and Tues classes)
- Grade 4 Tap/ Grade 5 Modern (Mon and Fri classes)

Chaperones

We will require parent chaperones for both the dress rehearsal and show day. All chaperones will need a DBS to help backstage. Those of you who obtained one for the last show can use it again this year. If you already have a DBS from your place of work (school etc) then this will also be accepted. We can not run the show without backstage help. Those who need a DBS will need to obtain one through me.
